## THE FULBRIGHT PROGRAM IN ITALY

- ➤ A binational Program started in Italy in 1948 and jointly funded by the Governments of the United States and of Italy
- ➤ Promotes cultural and academic exchanges between Italy and the United States through scholarships i.e. Master &Ph.D., research and lectureship activities) for Italians and U.S. citizens

to increase mutual understanding between the people of the United States and the people of Italy to give back to the recipient's home country upon returning

➤ Since 1948 more than 10,000 U.S. and Italian students, teachers, lecturers, and researchers have participated in the Fulbright Program in Italy

# **B.E.S.T. PROGRAM**

- As a way to promote cultural and academic exchanges between Italy and the U.S. the Commission administers the Business and Student Training (B.E.S.T.) Program
- ➤ 6 months scholarships for young Italians with a business idea
- ➤ 3 months of tailor-made coursework on technological innovation, marketing and finance at **Santa Clara University**
- ➤ 3 months of internship period with companies in the Silicon Valley area & participation in networking activities
- ➤ Mentoring activities upon grantees'return to Italy

# **FAST FACTS**

- Created in 2006 by the U.S. Amb. to Italy Ronald Spogli as a pilot Fulbright Program. The Program went through many transitions.
- ➤ Currently it falls under the Fulbright «broad» mandate to promote cultural and academic exchanges between Italy and the U.S.

  The Commission administers the competition.
- > To date:
  - 7 editions of the Program
  - **63** B.E.S.T. scholarships assigned
  - 37 start-up created
  - **30** mln € investments in the 37 start-up from international investors
  - 9,5 mln € total revenue generated by start-up activities
  - 320 jobs created
  - start up branches available in 4 nations: Italy USA, U.K., Singapore
